ABOUT THIS SHOWCASE

Austrade Korea will host an Australian Digital Health Innovation Showcase in Seoul to promote Australia's digital health technology capabilities to leading Korean industry players. The event provides a platform for Australian digital health organisations to connect with Korean businesses and research institutes seeking innovative technology partnerships and with Korean investors seeking investment opportunities for future growth. This event, sponsored by Korea Health Industry Development Institute (KHIDI) and the Korea Pharmaceutical and Bio-Pharma Manufacturers Association follows a series of successful Innovation Showcase programs in 2015 and in 2016 which presented Australian medical research capabilities to the Korean market.

The 2017 Australian Digital Health Technology Innovation Showcase is open to digital health startups, established companies, and research institutes seeking potential partners. Austrade Korea will arrange targeted business meetings for Australian participants with qualified Korean organisations in line with individual company objectives.

MARKET SNAPSHOT

- The Smart Healthcare Industry (a.k.a. Digital Health) is an important new growth engine for the Korean economy in the era of Industry 4.0. Various measures are taken by Ministries to foster Korea's Digital Health Industry but social acceptability is still lagging behind in terms of establishment of relevant laws and systems.
- The Korean government recently held several international and domestic seminars and forums under the theme of Industry 4.0 and seeks international collaborations in the areas of telemedicine, electronic medical record platforms, medical tourism, precision medicine, and big data in the healthcare insurance etc.
- Korean Ministry of Health and Welfare announced their Precision Medicine
 Technology Development Plan as part of the Nine National Strategic
 Project in 2016. The plan includes establishment of Precision Medicine
 Cohort and Global Standards with a goal of development of Next Generation Hospital Information System and establishment of AI based precision medicine infrastructure and ecosystems.

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- Developers of medical system software and solution platforms are most active in the supply value chain. Korea's largest technology firms, telecom operators and carriers are increasingly collaborating with Korea's top hospitals, as many of Korea's large hospitals are incorporating smart healthcare services such as Samsung Medical Centre, Seoul National University Bundang Hospital who was awarded the first Electronic Medical Record Adoption Model (EMRAM) State 7 hospital outside North America, etc.
- Some examples of Korea's top digital health technology firms include Samsung Electronics' Breezie in US for senior living environment, Samsung SDS' genomics and personalised wellness care technology, KT (Korea Telecom) MoU signing with Australian mobile stethoscope startup providing digital solutions.
